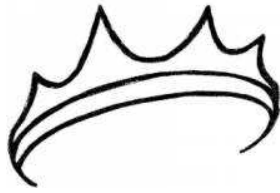

Teen Contestant:

Thank you for your interest in the 2012 Rankin County/Southwest and Dogwood Festival Outstanding Teen Pageant. If you are a resident of Rankin, Simpson, Lincoln, Copiah, Pike, Marion, Walthall, Lawrence, Franklin, Amite, Adams, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis and Wilkinson counties and between the ages of 13-17, never been married or pregnant you are eligible to compete for the Outstanding Teen Pageant. If you are a qualified resident of any counties in the state you are eligible to for the Dogwood Festival Outstanding Teen Pageant. The Miss Rankin County/Southwest's Outstanding Teen and Dogwood Outstanding Teen are *with* talent and athletic wear competition. All Teen winners will be represented at the Miss Mississippi's Outstanding Teen Pageant. Please complete the appropriate application form attached to this letter if you are planning of competing. The pageant is scheduled on **January 14th, 2012 6:00 PM** at Brandon High School on Highway 18. There will be a **general rehearsal on January 13th at 5:00 PM** at the *Brandon High School Auditorium*. Please make arrangements to attend this rehearsal; this is required so you will be acquainted with the show order and the opening number to be presented at the pageant night. Kindly take note of the following important things that you will need to turn in or prepare for the pageant:

- 1) Opening Number outfit: Interview Suit
- 2) Head shot photo minimum size 4X6 with your application: deadline January 6, 2012
- 3) Send 6 copies of completed fact sheets/application form on or before Jan. 6th 2012.
- 4) Required non-refundable fee \$100.00.
- 5) **Outstanding Teen Contestant:** You will need at least four outfits: 1) Interview suit 2) Evening Wear 3) Talent Outfit and 4) Sports Wear
- 6) **Outstanding Teen Contestant:** Bring your music in CD, musical instrument (except piano, BHS has a piano keyboard), and any props you will use for your talent competition at rehearsal night.
- 7) Report to Brandon High School Auditorium on January 14, 2012 at 12:00 Noon for your 6 minute interview with the judges. You must come in your interview suit.
- 9) Report to Brandon High School at 5:00 PM on January 14th, 2012 for the competition night.
- 9) If you are selling ads for the program book, you have to turn in your ad pictures and fees on or before January 6th. Contact the directors for more information on selling ad pages.
- 10) You are required to bring with you a Prince or Princess from ages 5 to 12 to serve as your escort during Evening Gown Competition. Participation Fee of \$35.00 is required for the Prince and Princess Program. Attire for the Prince: Long pants with Long Sleeve white shirt. Attire for the Princess: Long dress. No rehearsal is required for the Prince/Princess participants. They have to be present and fully attired during the pageant night. We will assign seats for them at the pageant.
